Study Passages of the Week

Exodus 25–33; Psalm 24

Theme or Focus

After Israel's sin with the golden calf, God reveals His name and character to Moses: a key theological moment repeated throughout Scripture. God is merciful and just, compassionate yet not indifferent to sin. This week's study includes tabernacle instructions, priestly roles, and covenant renewal. These chapters demonstrate God's desire to dwell among His people even amid their failure.

Psalm 24 reflects the holiness required to enter God's presence and affirms God as King of glory.
