Exodus 3:1–12

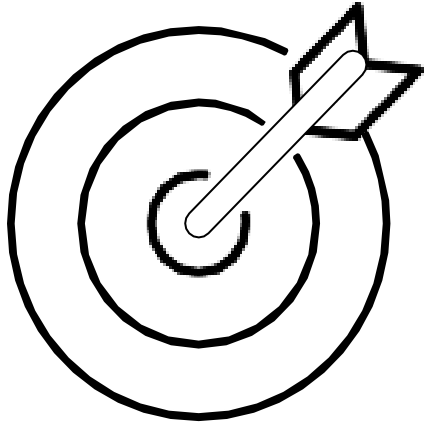
Study Passages of the Week

Exodus 1–2, 4–6; Psalm 21

Theme or Focus

God reveals Himself to Moses from a burning bush, calling him to lead Israel out of slavery. When Moses resists, God assures him with His name "I AM" and presence. This moment becomes central to Israel's theology: God sees, hears, remembers, and acts. These chapters trace God's preparation of Moses, the oppression of Israel, and the beginning of deliverance.

Psalm 21 expresses confidence in the strength of the Lord. A fitting anthem as God's rescue plan unfold.
